Unregulated Gaming

- Often called "skill" games or "sweepstakes" games

 A game of skill or a game of chance?
 Often confused with regulated and taxed distributed gaming
- Unregulated and untaxed
 - No background checks or licensure requirements
 - No consumer protections
 - No accountability
- Subject of new legislation and enforcement actions across the US
- Often disguised to mimic regulated Distributed Gaming machines



Distributed Gaming is not Unregulated Gaming

- Numerous states are struggling with some form of unregulated gaming
- These unregulated, untaxed gambling machines, often called "skill" or "sweepstakes" games, provide no consumer protections and no revenue to your state.
- Numerous state prosecutions are pending across the US to stop unregulated gambling machines.
- Distributed Gaming is regulated, licensed and taxed form of legal gambling.

THE BENEFITS OF Regulated Gaming Machines

Regulated gaming provides player protection, fosters stakeholder integrity, combats illegal activity, and generates much needed revenue for state funded programs.

RESPONSIBLE GAMING Responsible gaming programs that prevent minors from wagering, encourage consumers to play responsibly, and provide awareness of services available for problem gambling assistance. LICENSING AND BACKGROUND INVESTIGATIONS Licensing and background investigations of business entities, corporate officers, and key employees. CONSUMER PROTECTION Regulatory authority that will resolve consumer concerns and reinforce game play fairness. GAME TESTING Rigorous internal controls and independent laboratory testing of gaming machines. SECURE GAMING EQUIPMENT Operators support the security of machines through a regulatory shipping notification and control process for shipments into a state, outof-state, and intrastate. ANTI-MONEY LAUNDERING PROTOCOLS Federal anti-money laundering compliance including currency transaction reporting and suspicious transaction reporting to prevent funds from supporting illicit or unlawful activity.
